



The **European Voluntary Service** is an exchange program financed by the Swiss Confederation, which allows young people between <u>18 and 30 years</u> to do a voluntary service in a non-profit-making project in Europe.

Dates: From February 2019 till January 2020 (12 months)

Project: The **Stiftung Pro Gemeinsinn** is a non-profit organisation providing Kindergarten education and after school care. Its priority is educating children between 1 and 12 years and creating a positive environment in which the children can thrive, learn, enjoy and grow as human beings as well as feel recognized as important members of society. The voluntary service will be offered in the Afterschool-club "Kids Company I" in Berlin Waidmannslust, which is one of 14 projects of the Stiftung Pro Gemeinsinn. The club cooperates very close with the primary school Münchhausen, which is one of the very few Primaries offering French as first language.

The Stiftung Pro Gemeinsinn looks for a responsible volunteer with creative skills, native French mother tongue and basic German knowledge, motivated to work with children. The volunteer will participate in the everyday activities of the after school club and activities of the Primary school, including:

- Assistance to the teachers in activities in French and German language
- Work with children, this may include playing games, toy-making, reading, painting, music, sport, singing, etc;
- Assistance in preparation for events and festivals;
- Support to the children and staff in diverse other activities

Accommodation: The volunteer will live either in a host family or shared apartment. The project provides lunches and the volunteer will receive a food and transport allowance.

The EVS program is financed by the Swiss Agency Movetia. The grant includes: international transport costs, food and accommodation, pocket money, language support, health, accident and liability insurance.
