







The European Voluntary Service is an exchange program financed by the Swiss Confederation, which allows young people between 18 and 30 years of to do a voluntary service in a non-profit-making project in Europe.

Dates: From October 2018 till August 2019 (11 months)

Project: Ängsbacka in Molkom, Sweden. Ängsbacka is among the most important meeting places in Scandinavia for people who want to live a more conscious life, live from the heart and care for our planet. https://www.angsbacka.se/en/

The volunteer will learn about ecological interdependencies, organic gardening, living whole foods and about ecological sustainability through food consumption.

The volunteer will contribute at the organic garden where the organization grow salad greens, herbs and vegetables for their community as well as for their guests. She/he will learn the basics of organic growing and will develop her/his skills with land preparation, sowing, planting and harvesting. The volunteer will also work part of her/his time at Ängsbacka, at the kitchen, that is a vegan/vegetarian restaurant servicing up to 1000 guests during their biggest festivals. She/he will be engaged with preparing raw food (including fermentations) and developing the kitchen to use more local, seasonal and organic ingredients.

Accomodation: The volunteer will live in basic shared accommodation in Ängsbacka - in a double room. Ängsbacka provides 3 mostly organic vegetarian (vegan and gluten-free diets possible) meals per day, plus an opportunity to use volunteer kitchen.

The EVS program is financed by the Swiss Agency Movetia. The grant includes: international transport costs, food and accommodation, pocket money, language support, health, accident and liability insurance.
